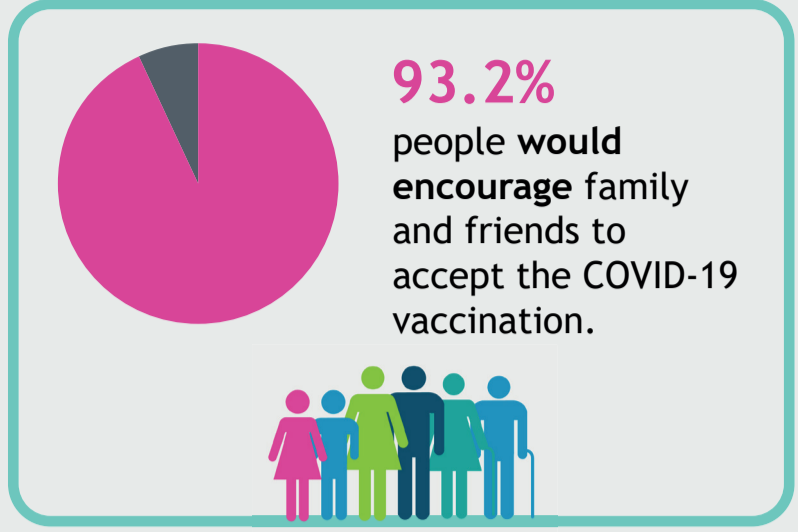
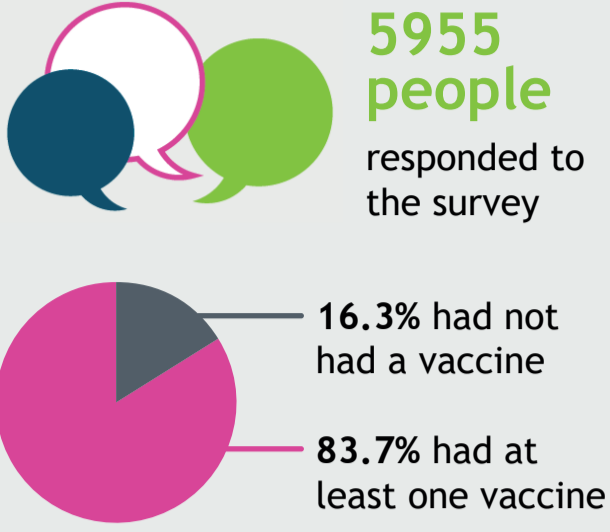
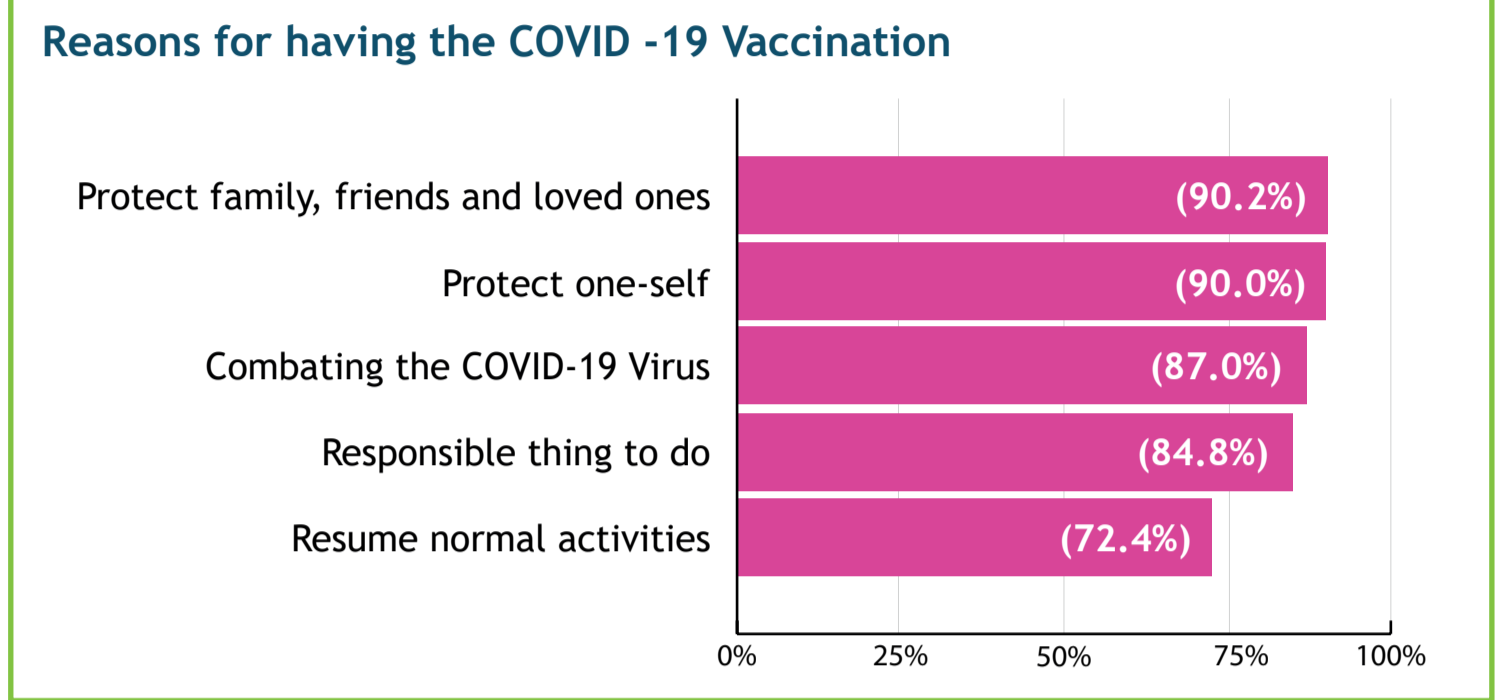


# People's experiences and views about Covid-19 vaccinations in Sussex

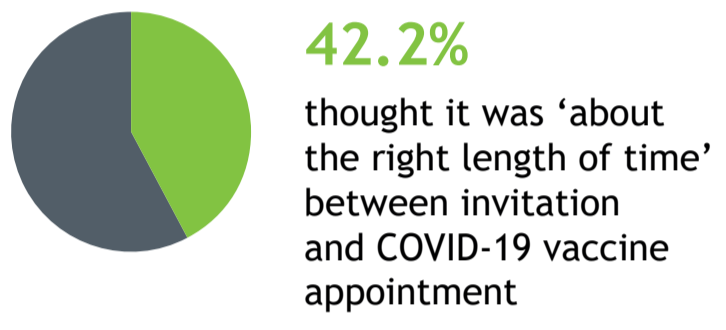
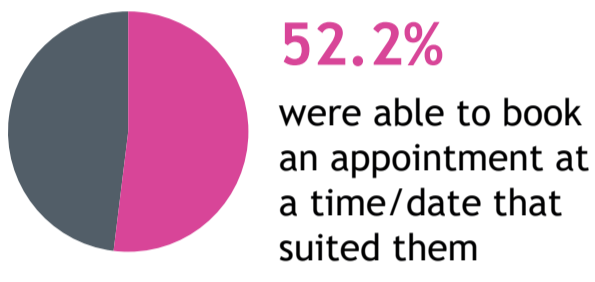

*'Outstanding service, just a huge testament to our public services in this country. Every staff member couldn't have been improved on, I felt hugely proud of and grateful to them.'*

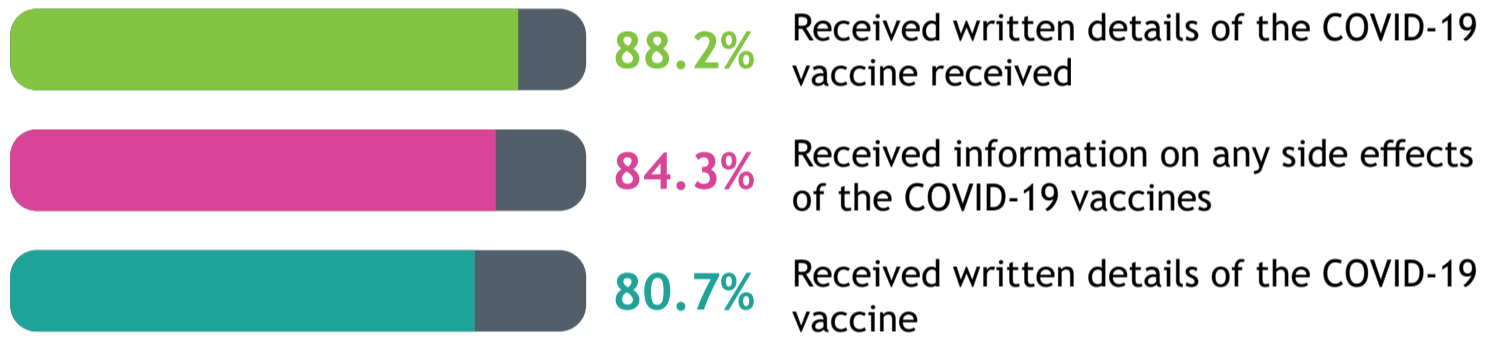


### General satisfaction with the appointment process



*'It was a very enjoyable experience. Everything was clear, the centre was well laid out and the staff and volunteers were very professional, welcoming and helpful.'*

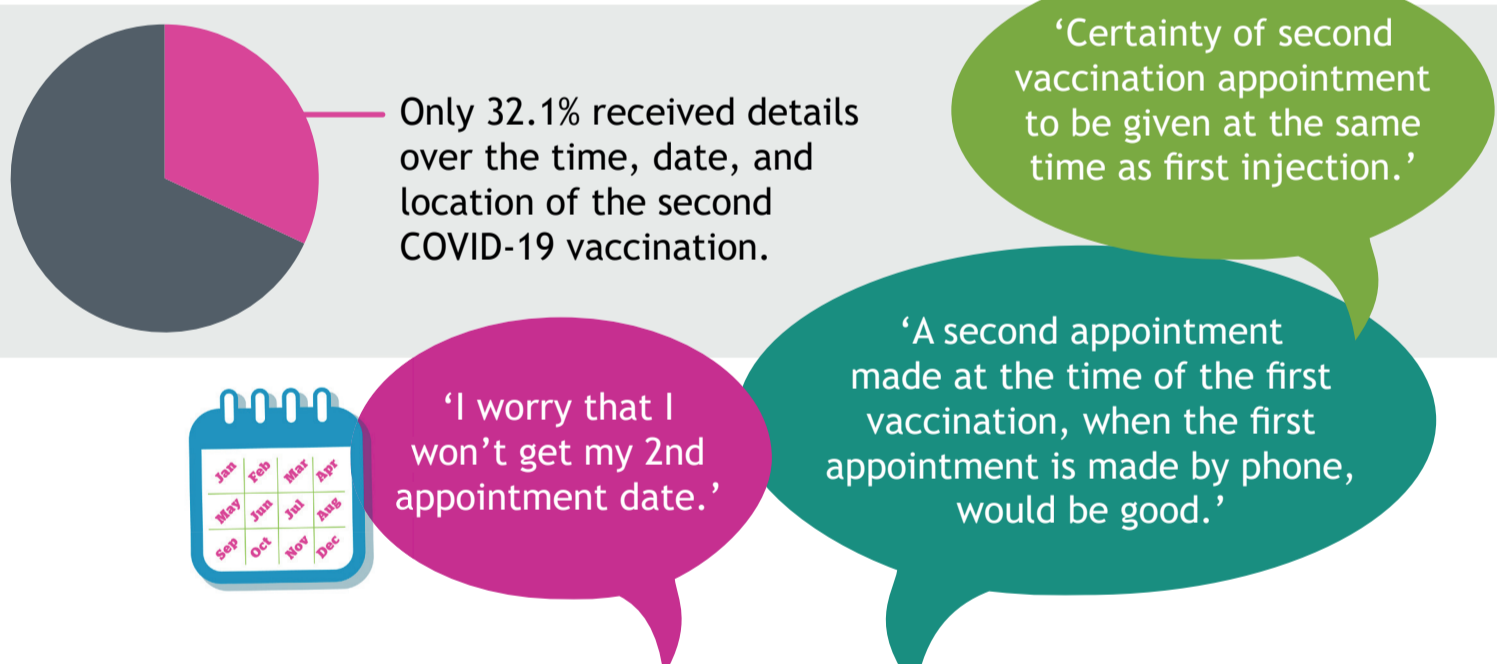
### Views on information and details people received after their COVID-19 Vaccination



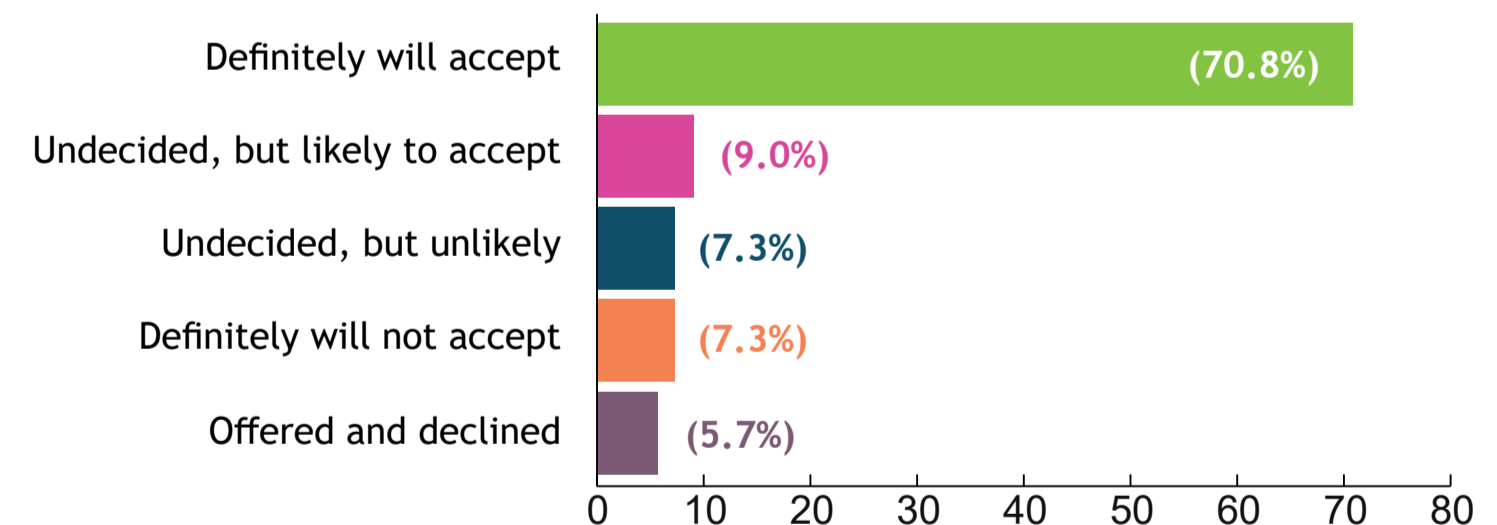
*'Very pleased with the helpfulness, friendliness and professionalism of the team at the racetrack.'*

*'Excellent experience. All very well organised, no waiting and friendly efficient staff and volunteers.'*

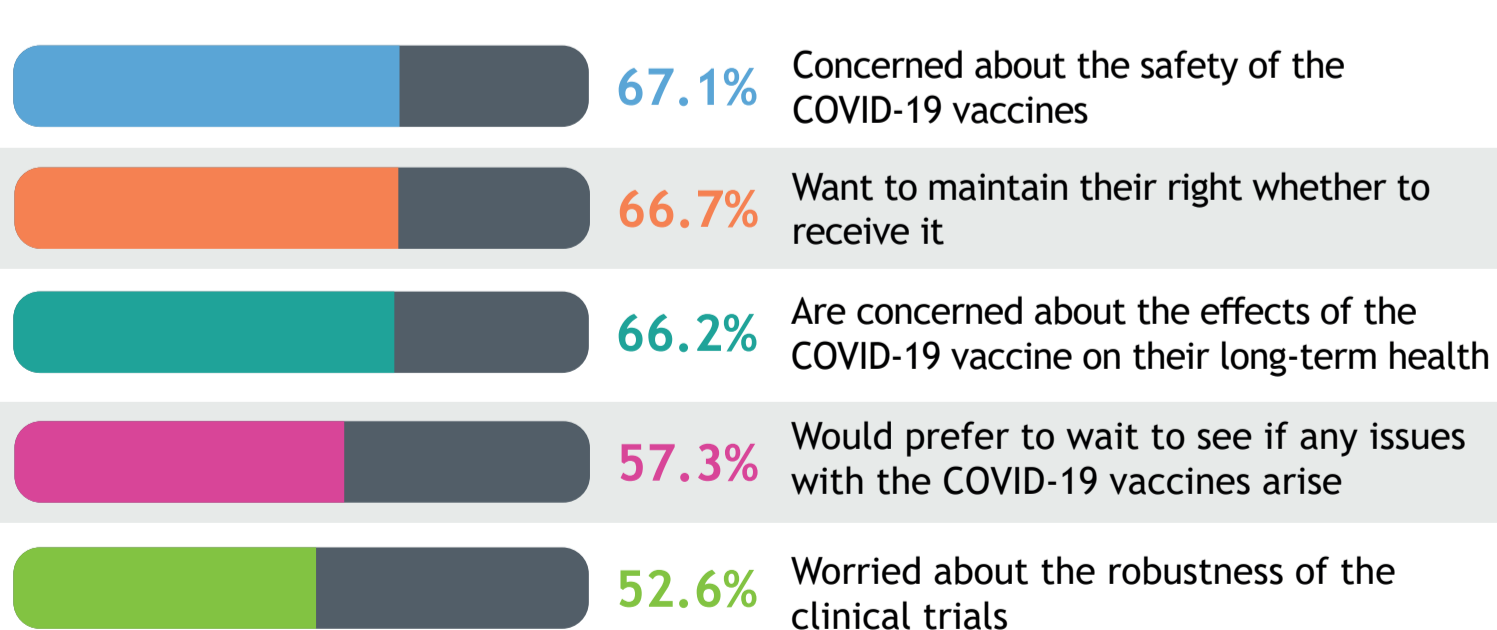
